## Festival Survival Tips

Make sure you are ready by the time specified. Festival organizers try to keep running as scheduled but may run early and do not make allowances for late arrivals not being ready to dance.

Once you arrive at the venue, locate a dressing room and get changed. Please arrive with hair and makeup done.

Find your teacher and group so you can get last minute instructions and practice. Parents are encouraged to sit in the audience and watch some of the performances at this time. This is a great time to invite friends and family to come and support your child if they are not able to attend our year-end recital, May 6th.

As an audience member, please be courteous and applaud all performers for their efforts.

Please wait for breaks between performances to find a seat or leave the auditorium. Volunteers will open doors to allow you to enter or leave.

Dancers will perform in their category and will then return to the stage for their adjudication and awards. Categories can be anywhere from 20 - 45 minutes long. Dancers will be supervised by their teacher until adjudication is finished. Parents can then meet their child in the lobby after adjudication.

### REMINDERS

- ⇒ Taking photos or video in NOT allowed under any circumstances, organizers will <u>disqualify</u> the group that is performing from the festival.
- ⇒ Turn off your cellphone

### Festival information continued

Costumes MUST be hung on a hanger in a garment bag for transport - NOT stuffed into a bag. Wrinkled costumes do not look attractive on stage. If you need to get wrinkles out please steam! The studio has a steamer available for anyone to use. Costumes have been sent home ready to wear for performance.

All dancers must wear tights with their costumes - NUDE bras (NO colours) - PLEASE no panties!!!

Keep all accessories that go with each costume in a labelled zip bag on the same hanger as the costume.

Label shoes, tights and accessories with name. Everything looks the same in the dressing room with a whole group of dancers altogether.

ALL dancers 6 years and up will require rhinestone earrings to wear onstage - this is part of their costume. We will have some available at the desk for viewing and for sale.

Hair supplies - comb, brush, bobby pins, hair pins, hair elastics that match your hair, bun nets for ballet (match your hair), hair spray, hair gel, rollers, flat iron/curling iron. Each individual teacher will specify hairstyle. If you need any tips or suggestions, please ask...we are happy to help.
